Recycled Circles: Mixed Media with Paper & Cloth **Jane LaFazio** **May 9th, 9:30-5:00**

Create a fabulous mixed media piece from your own cloth and a few paper scraps! As seen in "Cloth Paper Scissors" magazine [March 2009 issue] Jane's

Recycled Circles is a layered project that will teach you an assortment of techniques, while creating this guided, yet totally your own one of a kind art quilt. Each student's work will look very very different, even though we're all doing the same step by step process. The class is especially great for beginners, as you just can't go wrong!

Supply list:

- At least 8 different fabrics, fat quarters will be fine (one of the fabrics will be your background)
- Steam a seam II (no substitutions - you can share a package of 9x12")
- Scissors for fabric
- Batting (like low loft or whatever your preference) we'll be working 12x12" so bring a slightly larger piece
- Sewing machine (with regular walking foot)
- Sewing machine thread in contrasting colors
- Rotary cutter and cutting mat (you can share)
- For hand stitching: embroidery threads, needles
- Optional embellishments: buttons and beads (or you can do this at home)
- Extension cord for your machine
